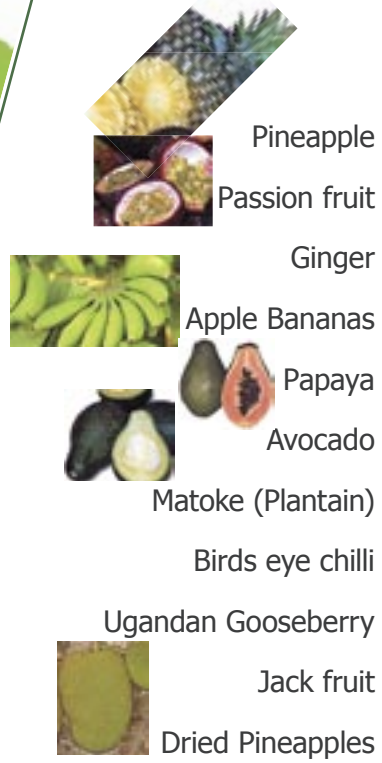

Food safety

Biofresh purchases produce from approved farmers only, who have been certified to grow organically by

Institute of Marketecology (IMO), Switzerland.

Biofresh is committed HACCP principals and aims at eliminating all the hazards associated with the process. All the critical control point CCP in the growing, transport, cooling, packing etc are identified, controlled and are closely monitored to ensure food safety. This is achieved through training of all staff.

Traceability

Accurate record keeping is key to Biofresh. Farm codes are indicated on every box from farm to customer. Through working closely with the small scale farmers, we know exactly where our produce comes from!

Fair trade

Biofresh produce is grown by 117 small scale farmers, who are individuals or in cooperatives. Biofresh buys the produce at premium prices thus improving

their livelihoods and boosting their morale and confidence. Farmers are also given bonuses annually to improve their communities and social standards. One cooperative is now able to obtain clean portable water from a borehole dug using the annual premiums! The small scale farmers also receive free training on growing organically, subsistence farming, conservation of the environment and more.
